INTRODUCTION

Silently Shedding Tears

Every major country in the world has identified its enemy-oppressor and after fighting and eliminating, it gradually proceeded on its way to progress. The only major country — second only in population to China— which is not able to identify its blood-sucker is India. The task of identifying the enemy-oppressor thus became much more difficult, if not almost impossible, after the country became "independent" in 1947.

The only period when the enemy-oppressor was identified and effectively tackled was the 1,000-year-long Budhist rule which is rightly considered by historians as the "Golden Period of Indian history". "Independent" India was grateful enough to recognise this period by putting the Asoka Chakra in the country's national flag and adopting it as the national emblem.

It was during this period, the oppressed people were able to **identify** the enemy-oppressor because of the powerful crusades of the Budha.

But soon the tiny Brahminical forces managed to defeat it by infiltrating into Budhism and breaking it from both within and without. This is the beginning of the fall and fall of India, followed by a series of tragedies in quick succession. Many foreign invasions, one after the other followed. India never again raised its head.

The worst period of Indian history followed the so-called independence of India, that handed over the country to its original Brahminical oppressors who today are ruling over the massive 1,300 million population – neither dead nor living. The ruling class with its captive media power is

putting out false stories of "India jumping", rising, shining, soaring, roaring. All bullshit — to fool the gullible masses.

This tiny book is presented to the dumb-driven overwhelming suffering majority (85%) who cannot even read the language of this book. This is another face of the tragedy. The country is deliberately kept illiterate and steeped in superstition.

Through *Dalit Voice* of which we are the Editor, we have tried to "educate" the country for 30 long years, written over 100 books, but our contribution is like dropping two bags of sugar into the Arabian Sea.

India's Brahminical ruling class (less than 15%) is "highly educated", well-informed, rich and powerful with international connections. Despite having all these achievements it is in a state of permanent crisis—afraid of its own shadow.

The country is passing through crisis after crisis – external and internal.

Having read history many times we have no hope of the rulers learning any lessons from history. They are not interested to learn because the arrogance they suffer from make them pretend they know everything.

We are deeply worried because the overwhelming (85%) sub-humans are dumb and deaf — treated by the rulers like a wasteful commodity. The other 15% is not interested in learning anything new or forgetting anything old. We are crushed between this devil and deep sea — silently shedding tears.

1. Who is ruling India? And how?

During our "graduation" from Marxism to Ambedkarism in the 1980s we had written four important books — (1) Class-Caste Struggle: Emerging Third Force (1980), (2) Who is Ruling India? (1982), (3) The Dilemma of Class & Caste in India (1984), (4) Karl Marx & Dr. Ambedkar (1988) and (5) How Marx Failed in Hindu India (1988)— all went into three editions. In the third one we had reproduced the text of the Manuwadi Marxist leader, the late E.M.S. Namboodiripad's scurrilous attack on us. Since then we had completely abandoned the Indian version of Manuwadi Marxism which the ruling Brahminists used to convert themselves into the country's ruling class.

Brahminism, the super fine ideology of the Indian ruling class (15%), has no permanent party but only permanent interests. The latest evidence is the way the Brahminical order kicked out its own *Brahmana Jati Party* (BJP) and brought the country's more cunning, original Brahminical party of Congress to power in the parliament election (*Dalit Voice* Edit June 1, 2009: "*Mere 2% anti-Advani upper caste vote swing from BJP brought about spectacular Cong. victory*").

Fear of identifying the ruling class

After over 20 years we are further clarifying our thoughts on the Indian ruling class and how we arrived at the conclusion that the Brahmins (3%) indeed are the rulers with the Kshatriyas, Vaishyas plus some *shudra* landed castes in tow. Our almost 30 years of experience as the Editor of *Dalit Voice* has reinforced our thoughts and led us to this conclusion.

Ashok Rudra, called a marxist economist of the Vishwa Bharati University, Shantiniketan, in his booklet, *Intelligentsia as a Ruling Class*, more or less says the same thing — of course without identifying the ruling class.

Nobody in India has the courage to **identify** the Brahmins as the principal rulers for fear of facing threat to their very survival.

Brahmins very often question us how such a micro-minority population can be the rulers and point out the fact that the political class, often mistaken to be the country's real ruling class, has hardly any Brahmin. This is true. The Prime Minister or most of the state chief ministers are not Brahmins.

This is the case in USA also where a mere 2% Jews hold the neck of the country, including its political power — of course without being in the driver's seat.

Political power is no power

But political power is no power in India. Politicians are a puppet in the hands of the ruling class. The best example to prove this point is the mere 2% American Jews who do not hold any political power in USA. But it is the Jews as the king-makers who hold the real power in the US with the entire financial sector and media power in their pocket. This is also true in England, France and Germany, all Christian countries, which live under the mercy of Jews.

Prime Minister Manmohan Singh may be today's (2010) Prime Minister but being a World Bank nominee he automatically becomes the darling of the Brahminical rulers. In fact he is a better Brahmin than the best.

The ruling class need not necessarily hold the political power but it still rules with its power to manipulate the "public opinion" which is the case in India.

In US and Europe, the Jews hold the reins mainly because of their financial and media power.

The European ruling Christians had a long- lasting religious war with the Jews throughout history, but after the World War-II they simply surrendered to the Jews. Even the Pope dare not go against the Jews. President Barack Obama is challenged by the entire Jewish diaspora, led by the Zionist Israel. And finally he became a loyal servant of the Jews. Look how Iran was made to tremble just because it elected Ahmedinejad as the President, hated by the entire zionists. Such is the power of the micro-minority Jews. Zionist Israel, a dot in the map of the world, controls the Western world.

Unparalleled example of India

But in India the ruling Brahminical micro-minority of 3% or even less enjoys such a powerful sway over the country, even to the extent of a total mind control over the entire masses of people because of its legendary religious and manipulative power since thousands of years.

Brahminism is an ideology, wrongly described religious and sacred, that declares the Brahmins as the highest people by birth and birthright, *Bhoodevatas* (gods on earth), that the Vedas are the source of authority, and that the rites and rituals that make up the *Varnashrama Dharma* (caste system) are sacred and must be followed.

In Christian US and Europe, the Jews do not have such a religious control on the country and its peoples but in India Brahminical people being the custodians of their artificially manufactured "Hindu religion", enjoy the highest ritual status, becoming the virtual *Bhoodevatas*, gods on earth — a status which no section of the population enjoys in

any part of the world except India. The secret of the Brahmin strength is the caste system, the steel frame that stood still since it destroyed Budhism.

Shudras & BCs as oppressors

That is how the Brahminists constitute the Intelligentsia because they control not only the country's principal religion (Hindu) but also all its gods, scriptures — and finally the very value system.

Dr. B.R. Ambedkar, the Father of India, has said all these things long back and hence no need to repeat the argument that the Brahmins (3%) constitute the ruling class of India.

Thougth vs. Action

A vocal section within the Dalit community, however, has been lately arguing that it is not the Brahmins who are kicking, killing, burning, raping and destroying the little property of the Dalits in the rural side but the landed *shudra* and Backward Castes. They cite the example of the Khairlanji massacre of Dalits in Maharashtra and ever so many places. There is good lot of truth in this argument. Brahminical journalists have invested a lot in making the Dalits believe this argument.

It is a fact that all over India it is the *shudra*, the BC or OBCs who are culprits in all anti-Dalit pogrom. We know it. But what is important is not the **ACTION** of looting and killing the Dalits. But the **THOUGHT**, the inspiration behind the **ACTION**.

Caste hatred is the real villain

The moment the mosquito bites you, one hand instantly acts to slap the mosquito and kills it or drives it away. Who gave the order to the hand to attack the mosquito? It is

the brain. The order to attack the mosquito came from the brain. Therefore, the brain that orders the attack is more important than the hand which simply obeyed the order.

Some urchins throw a stone at a running dog. But even such a brainless animal does not chase the stone or growl at the stone. It gets angry and chases the fellow who threw the stone. Even the dog has that much of brain to identify the culprit.

Here the culprit is not the stone but the boy who throws the stone. Who gave the poisonous thought to the *shudras* and OBCs to kick or kill the Dalit? The Brahminical *Bhoodevata* philosophy. It is the value system that governs a society. In the case of India, this value came from its Brahminist thought.

In all anti-Dalit atrocities the crime is committed by the *shudras* or BCs. There is no dispute on this. But the culprit behind the curtain is the Brahminical thought of caste hatred, daily injected into the veins of the *shudras* and BCs who consider themselves superior. The ascending order of reverence and the descending degree of contempt that makes the Hindu value system.

Culprits behind anti-Muslim riots

This is also true in the case of all anti-Muslim riots. In the Babri Masjid demolition, the Dalits played a major role. In the Gujarat Genocide (2002), Dalits led the anti-Muslim violence. We know it. But it is the Brahminical thought that made the innocent Dalits attack and kill Muslims against whom Dalits have no grouse as both are blood brothers. Brahminical terrorist parties like the RSS etc. plan anti-Christian, Sikh riots but executed by the Dalits and Backward Castes.

Marathas hate Brahmins

In Maharashtra, the Marathas (*Shiv Dharma*) are furious with Brahmins and have launched a powerful campaign against Brahmins. But in Khairlanji the same Marathas and their cousins Kunbis and other OBCs killed the Dalits.

The Marathas and Kunbis hate Brahmins for riding them and yet they also hate the Dalits who are the worst victims of Brahminism. Who is managing this two-way action of the Marathas and Kunbis? The Brahminical hand behind the curtain.

Punjab's Dalit-Jat Sikh clashes

This is the case in all anti-Dalit and anti-Muslim war and violence where the principal villain is the Brahmin whose value system has brainwashed the *shudras* and BCs to hate the Dalits and Muslims. In the latest (May 25, 2009) bloody Punjab explosion of Dalit anger against Jat Sikhs on the issue of the Vienna murder of a Dalit saint, the Brahminical hand (or is it the RAW?) is clearly visible behind the curtain.

Belief system

The violence against Dalits on one side and Muslims on the other keep the Indian society permanently divided. Brahminism thrives through such a divide and rule game.

Because Brahminism has its powerful monopoly media it can manufacture any spurious argument and sell it as the supreme truth. Besides, anybody selling this spurious product is given award and reward plus publicity in the mass media which is the sole Brahminical monopoly. Anything that comes in the media is considered supreme truth. Because, a powerful belief system has been so systematically developed and nurtured that we are made to believe anything the manuwadi media says.

Brahmins hate caste but defend caste system

And that is how a section of the gullible Dalits are "convinced" that Brahmins are good but the *shudras* and BCs are the criminals.

The solution to this endless anti-Dalit caste atrocities and also anti-Muslim riots is not merely punishing the *shudras* and BCs. Yes, this is also a must. But the more important and ever lasting solution is the destruction of the very caste system (Hinduism) for which the Brahmins are not ready. They want the anti-Dalit war and violence must end by punishing the *shudras* and BCs but keeping in tact the Brahminical Social Order which is the cause of action.

The beauty is the Brahmins hate only the "caste" but want the caste system (Hinduism) to remain in tact. As they constitute the ruling class they can enforce anything beneficial to them.

Quite a number of Brahmins have criticised us for describing them as the country's ruling class. Their defence is there are hardly any Brahmin in the Union Cabinet or any state cabinet. They say the power to rule has percolated from the Brahmin downwards to the landed *shudras* and Backward Castes. Yes. They are right.

It is the thought that rules — not the person

Those who pinpoint this are depending upon a concept of "ruling class" which has the power to confuse those who are willing to be confused.

A ruling class need not necessarily rule —at least not directly. The process and the power of ruling a society comes from a **THOUGHT**. It is the **THOUGHT** that rules — not the person who sits in the chair.

Whoever that sits in the chair is guided by this very same

thought, propounded and promulgated by the Brahmin. The current Indian Prime Minister is a Sikh but his value system is Brahminical and he is surrounded by the Brahmins.

Whether it is the legislature, judiciary, bureaucracy, the defence forces — they all constitute the state. The people who function at the different levels of the above limbs of the state need not necessarily be the Brahmin but they are all guided by the supreme Brahminical thought.

Who can become the temple priest

That is how even to this day the state continues to uphold the principle that a born Brahmin alone must be the temple *archaka* (priest). The *archaka* post may be the lowest and the least paid. Yes. The position and the pecuniary benefit is not that matters. There are any number of people ready to hold this post for a lesser salary. The Supreme Court itself decided that a born Brahmin alone can be the temple *archaka* and none else. Such a decision is being blindly obeyed because it implies that the person of the Brahmin alone is holy, sacred and divine.

The *tirtha* (sacred water) can come only from the *shankha* (conch). What comes out from other things is just water —not *tirtha*. Such a racist rule governs Hindu India even to this day.

Ruling class need not rule

The rural kulaks and industrial tycoons do constitute a part of the ruling class. But it is subordinate to the Brahmin because his person alone is holy, sacred and divine.

In other words the ruling class cannot be defined by the act of ruling. It is the **thought** that rules. Not the person who holds the power. This was so throughout the Indian history. Even during the 800 to 1,000 years of Muslim rule it

was the Brahmins who have been the prime ministers and the real rulers.

The ruling class need not necessarily rule but its **thought** serves the interests of that class as against the interests of the other non-ruling classes.

Dr. Ambedkar verdict

In other words the govt, has to serve the interests of the ruling class. If it does not, that govt, will be removed.

How does the ruling class rule? How does the ruling class see that its interests are promoted and protected?

This question can be easily understood when it concerns the interests of Muslims (15%), Christians (2.5%), Sikhs (2.5%). And particularly the Dalits (20%) and Tribals (10%). Even the Backward Castes (35%). Almost 85% of the country's toiling masses have been complaining ever since "independence" of consistent and continuous discrimination, if not total neglect.

Media keeps out Dalits

All of them have invariably pointed their accusing finger at the Brahminical rulers. Dr. Ambedkar was the most prominent among the leaders of this underclass which singled out the Brahminical class as the only cause of their plight and persecution.

That is how the Indian state has been openly hostile to the interests of the Dalits, tribals, OBCs, Muslims, Christians and Sikhs. Over 85% of the population.

The state is hostile because the ruling class wants it to be so. The Brahminical interests will be served only if the state is against the interests of the *Bahujan Samaj* (the majority society).

The composition of the country's media — print and electronic — will help us understand which one is India's ruling class. A survey was made in the capital city of Delhi (DV Edit April 1, 2008: "Media monopoly helps upper castes to rule India by suppressing truth". & p. 5: "Brahmins hold 49% top jobs in national media") and the finding was that the capital's journalistic fraternity is totally Brahminical with hardly any representation from Dalits. There may be here and there some Muslims but they are chosen only after finding out their loyalty to the ruling class. (Dalit Voice, Oct. 16, 2009, p. 19: "Brahmin-Bania stranglehold on media is fact of history", Dr. Jamanadas).

Ruling class is the Intelligentsia

Ashok Rudra in his treatise refers to the "Indian ruling class". He says the country's "Intelligentsia" is the ruling class and he defines this class as those "persons who earn their living by the sale of mental labour". This class does not include businessmen. He lists five categories of people:

(1) White collar employees, (2) employees in govt. services, (3) teachers, lawyers, judges (4) artists, journalists, writers), (5) professional politicians.

Mischief of middle class

It is these five classes often described in the media as the "middle class", which is the euphemism used to hide the "ruling class".

Meira Kumar as pet dog

Are there no members of the SC/ST/BC or Muslim/ Christian/Sikh in this "middle class"? Yes there are. They will be admitted to this exclusive club of closed coterie only after testing their value system. Once they are found to toe the Brahminical line they will be not only admitted but paraded as a pet dog. Presently Ms. Meira Kumar (Speaker of the Lok Sabha), a Dalit, is on the parade. Farukh Abdullah was hailed as a secular Muslim.

The ruling class, therefore, need not be necessarily Brahminical. Underdogs ready to eat the Brahminical shit will be its honoured members. That is how an OBC oilcrushing lowly *jati* fellow, Narendra Modi, is being projected as the future PM for his sterling quality of killing 2,500 Muslims in the "Gujarat Genocide - 2002".

Hanuman as the stooge

In other words, the ruling class need not necessarily be the Brahmin. Bum-lickers are most welcome to join this exclusive club as *chamchas* and *chaprasis* to carry out the job of disciplining the SC/ST/BCs and Muslim/Christian/Sikhs.

What is important is your ideology. Your value system. Not necessarily the caste. To that extent the caste rigidity is relaxed. But not the Brahminical ideology. The thought is never compromised. Underdogs who subscribe to this thought are admitted — but closely watched. The monkey (Hanuman) god of the *Ramayana* cock and bull story is the best example of such a stooge.

A member of the Brahminical ruling class need not be rich. But he must have the ability to propagate the ruling class thought.

Why Paswan is loved

What is important is the Brahminical **thought** and the one who upholds this thought need not be a Brahmin. Ram Vilas Paswan, an Untouchable, is the blue-eyed boy of the Brahmins because he is a volatile votary of the Brahminical thought.

Women's Bill

. . .

Women's Reservation Bill is a good example to prove the power of the ruling Brahminical class which wants 1/3 seats in parliament to be reserved for women so that it can fill up parliament with their women.

But SC/ST/BCs and Muslims say that women's reservation is fine but their women must also have the quota within the quota. In a democracy every section has the right to be represented. It is their democratic right but the rulers have denounced the opponents as anti-women and the media is painting them as women-haters. All those who depend on this *manuwadi* media are made to believe their version. Rulers believe what they want to believe and also make others believe. This is the power of the ruling class.

Education goes to dogs

There is not a single media except the *Dalit Voice* which has denounced the proposed women's Bill as antiwoman.

Take the education field, which is the most important sector to shape the **thoughts** of the youth. It is here that we find a total domination of the Brahmin. Its interest is in the higher education to prepare their kids for overseas jobs and *kushy* living. So much so the entire primary and elementary education has gone to dogs.

Dismissal from Indian Express

Dangerous values are injected into the veins of the youth through the textbooks which are prepared by the Brahminical writers. Education, journalism, TV, cinema, theatre, painting, culture etc. are all dominated by this class. These are the principal thought-manufacturing factories which are closely guarded. We were dismissed from the *Indian Express* only because we challenged this Brahminical thought which none dare do.

Money corruption

India today is considered one among the most corrupt countries in the world. Money corruption is not the only variety of corruptions. Rather, money corruption is the last of the four varieties of corruption: (1) Money corruption, (2) moral corruption, (3) caste corruption and (4) intellectual corruption.

The last, intellectual corruption, is the worst form of corruption and this field is the total monopoly of the Brahminical rulers

Money corruption is the last and the least harmful varieties of corruption.

Since the rulers themselves are corrupt, every other section in the society has also become corrupt. And that is how the money corruption — the most visible form of corruption — has become so rampant. Supreme Court judges themselves are being mentioned by fellow judges. When the Hindu temples could be the fountain head of corruption every other form of corruption is effectively sealed and safeguarded.

Corrupt fellows hailed

In other words, it is the **thought** that has to be clean and sublime. It is the **thought** which manufactures and shapes an ideology. When the **thought** itself is corrupt and the media promotes it, as a country India is simply sinking. (*India As a Failed State*, DSA-2004).

The beauty of the Indian society is that it is not happy with an incorruptible person. He becomes an unfit and avoided, if not cursed. His own wife, parents and the family feels the fellow is useless. They say he is unhelpful. The corrupt fellow is not only popular but very much liked by the society. Because he adjusts himself to any occasion and any person. That is how the corrupt person, whether a minister, judge, bureaucrat or any official is extremely popular. It is the incorruptible, simple living person who is called useless and spurned by the society.

Why the Indian society has come to lionise Ketan Parekh, Harshad Mehta, IPL (cricket) boss Lalit Modi, a Marwari Bania, the 2010 Commonwealth Games chief Kalmadi etc. because they corrupted the entire system and the Brahminical rulers carried them on their head as if they are our model.

The example of Gandhi

The best and the most famous example is M.K. Gandhi hailed as the "Father of the Nation" by the entire corrupt class of the country. To this day we have not heard one dissenting voice. Anybody condemning Gandhi is called mad if not anti-national. And shot.

The gandhian values are nothing but Brahminical values. That sums up why the entire stinkingly corrupt fellows worship this Gujarati Bania.

Kerala CM hated

Who can save such a society which praises and parades persons who are killers like Narendra Modi, Harshad Mehta. Look: Achutanandan, the most popular CM of Kerala, a man of character, incorruptible, becomes the most hated person in the marxist party.

Brahminical thought not only grows out of corruption but breeds only corruption — particularly intellectual

corruption which is the fountain head of all other three varieties of corruption. Look at the lionising of the Ambanis who never pay the income tax.

That is how in the latest parliament election (2008) money power was so brazenly used to win but none bothered about it. Even MPs with criminal past were co-opted because they are all products of Brahminism.

That is how our property, posts and wealth are all concentrated in the hands of a micro-minority 15% of the country's 1,200 million population.

Role of media

All this socialist shibboleth, *Aam Admi Andolan* are bullshit. Brahminical rulers are ruling us only with the help of their Brahminical media.

The communists are the essential part of this conspiracy to keep the country in the Brahminical hands.

Caste-wise census, income statistics are all prohibited because that would reveal which castes have prospered at whose cost.

Poverty yardstick

The rulers have ruled that "economic yardstick" (poverty) should be the sole criterion for backwardness and not the time-tested "caste". Because if caste is taken as the yardstick, over 65% of the SC/ST/BCs and socially backward Muslims and Christians will come under the "Backward list" and if the funds are diverted to their welfare they will gain and challenge the Brahminical hegemony. Right from the Brahminical judiciary, media and the govt. all of them have fallen in line with this Brahminical THOUGHT.

Did we not say that it is the **THOUGHT** that rules and not the person in authority?

Half the people of India live below the poverty line. And they are all enterfained and made dumb and deaf by preaching them Hindu thoughts of papa, punya, punar janma (rebirth), fate — all dangerous thoughts which again make them pour their little savings into the coffers of the temples. The proverbial Indian poverty in fact enriches the rulers and helps them remain as rulers.

Manufacturers of Brahminical ideology (thought) — which is a big business — are all flourishing because they help the rulers to keep the 2/3 of the country's have-nots as slaves.

Cricket to entertain the masses

They are entertained by the cricket fever which is yet another ruling class poison to keep the masses enthralled.

Education system is chaotic. India is shortly becoming the world's largest country of illiterates. Who cares?

How to keep the SC/ST/BCs and Muslim and Christian poor, powerless and enslaved is the sole guiding rule of the "intelligentsia" who are the country's ruling class. It is this ruling class which provides the leadership to the country.

Ruling class never identified

This intelligentsia constitutes the Brahminical class—though no writer or speaker has the courage to **identify** and name this country's principal contradiction.

That is how we get a daily dosage of hate mails and even threats. For what? For **identifying** the enemy oppressor. The Brahminical advice to us is: "You go on writing all your muck without **identifying** the oppressor" so that the ruling

Brahminical class goes on sucking the blood uninterrupted, without being **identified**, without being named.

They have introduced several provisions in the Indian Penal Code (IPC) to punish and finish those who **identify** the enemy.

Parashuram slaughters Kshatriyas

The Kshatriyas, now called Thakurs, immediately "below" the Brahmin in the *Chaturvarna* order (the other name for the caste system), were literally slaughtered in thousands by the Brahmin killer god, Parasurama. The Chitpavan Brahmins, who produced Nathuram Godse, the killer of M.K. Gandhi, proudly displayed the huge cutout of their god at their recent (2008) *jati* conference at Pune.

Kshatriya surrender

Kerala is called the *Parasurama Shristi*. The Brahmin-Kshatriya rivalry and hatred was so bitter and deep. But soon they surrendered to Brahmins and since then acted as the bodyguards of the *Bhoodevatas*. The Vaishya (Banias) has the third-ranking poverty-stricken *varna* status. In Bihar, the Banias are classified under the Backward Castes. It is only M.K. Gandhi, a Gujarati Vaishya, who lifted his *jatwalas* and made them moneybags on the condition they will forever remain loyal to the *Bhoodevatas*. Today, the Banias earn billions and feed the *Bhoodevatas*. Perfect understanding.

Shudras won over

That is how the Brahmins co-opted the Kshatriyas and later the Vaishyas.

The shudras, forming the fourth varna of the Hindu

Chaturvarna, have been the blood enemies of the Bhoodevatas. The anti-Brahmin movement that waged during the British rule and immediately after the "independence" was led by the landed shudra castes like the Marathas, Jats, Reddis, Patels, Nairs, Vokkaligas, Mudaliars, Naidus etc. But soon they were also co-opted and that is how the mere 3% Bhoodevatas consolidated their position by enlarging their strength to 15% of the country's population and became the ruling class of India.

Goodbye to land reform

The *shudras* are essentially the country's landed gentry. They were co-opted to the ruling class by not implementing the land reform. In the rural area land is power. The *shudra* power is allowed to reign supreme and thereby co-opted to the BSO.

This 15% ruling class has all the wealth, education, ritual status, physical strength, beauty, caste superiority, personality, landed property. And that is how it became the country's ruling class — guided and supervised by the 3% Brahminical micro-minority "intelligentsia" — frustrating every socio-economic-cultural "reforms" launched since "independence".

Swiss Bank account-holders

Of course there are exceptions to the rule. But please note it is the exception that proves the rule. Take the case of the people having secret accounts in the Swiss banks. Or the latest list of multi-billionaires published in the *Times of India*. Are there anybody from the SC/ST/BCs? Or even Muslim or Christian? There may be one or two but they are the exceptions that only prove the rule. The rule is the 15% Brahminical Social Order is the ruling class. Manmohan Singh or even his grand father will have no

courage to touch the Swiss bank hidden money.

How the Kshatriyas and Vaishyas were co-opted? The *Bhoodevatas* used social, economic, political and even psychological weapons to annex them into their fold. Today, all the three are together and united. Once the three most powerful *dwija varnas* came together, annexing the "unthinking" *shudras* was no problem.

Gods on earth

That is how the Brahminical people became the unquestioned leaders — not only politically but also economically. What gave the solid strength to their leadership is their supreme ritual status as the *Bhoodevatas*, meaning the gods on earth.

Whether it is the Congress, BJP or even the communist parties the *Bhoodevatas* shall be the guiding spirit. Their unwritten law extends to every sphere — media, education, commerce and industry, judiciary — and even sports which in Hindu India means only cricket — the only "game" that suits the *idli-sambar* grass-eaters.

Even if there is a revolution in India, it can be led only by a *Bhoodevata*. That is how E.M.S. Namboodiripad became the country's greatest marxist and finally presided over the death of marxism. M.N. Roy, a Bengali Brahmin, became the founder of Indian Communist Party.

"Mahatma" shot dead

Budha, Guru Ravidas, Mahatma Phule, Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar, Sri Narayana Guru, Periyar E.V. Ramaswamy and many more worked to destroy this ruling class and its Hindu caste system. And in the process they only got destroyed. The Muslims realised the supreme truth belatedly and sought a separate homeland (Pakistan).

The *Bhoodevatas* used the "Gandhi weapon" to fight the Muslims and as soon as the Mahatma succeeded he was shot dead by a Chitpavan Brahmin (*Why Godse Killed Gandhi?*, DSA-1997).

Two powerful enemies

As this is written we are in total darkness. The country itself is sinking, surrounded by deadly enemies all around. Two powerful enemies of Brahmins are threatening India—the Muslim Pakistan on one side and communist China on the other side. And to their utter shock, the USA is economically, militarilly and politically losing its sole super power status—challenged by China.

Even the "thinking" *Bhoodevatas* themselves are not getting sound sleep in the night. Anything and everything they touch is turning into charcoal.

We the oppressed over 85% are helpless. But here we have a unique country — the only one in the world $\frac{k}{}$ where the rulers themselves are deeply worried. Feeling insecure. Suspecting their own shadows.

The country is neither living nor dead. It is brain dead. Its name is "Hindu India".



2 - The crimes of the "middle class"

India is undergoing a serious moral, social, cultural, political, economic crisis. And what not. Our good old value system is itself collapsing. And such an all-round crisis is simply mounting as days pass.

We have been saying all this in fits and bits and hence an elaboration of our anguished cry.

If you ask an urban educated — particularly the English-speaking *wala* — he will simply dismiss our statement and say such a gloom is the creation of prophets of doom like the *Dalit Voice*.

Stock market decides everything

A real, truthful situation of the country is never reported, never discussed. Many times even senior journalists are not realising that the home that is India, in which we are all living, is indeed crumbling — if not on fire. Only a "seeing eye" can make out the gravity of the situation.

Particularly the English-knowing walas are ever kept "optimistic". Their ever-alert eyes and ears are focused on the stock market.

Obsessed with growth

This paradox of India's "new prosperity"— so much advertised by the country's most maddening English daily, *Times of India*— is that it is guided by the stock market without understanding that India's stock (share)-holders do not constitute even 2% of our population.

"Market optimism" so assiduously built by the media is only misleading us — forcing us to be obsessed with "growth". Whose growth? If this urban-dwelling, upper caste leisured

class go on growing at the cost of the rest of India it will lead to more violence—represented by the maoists who are already in charge of 1/3 of India.

India will break into pieces

Social tensions boiling under the surface will simply explode. The chattering class may say they will force the govt. to use military to open fire on the rebellious under class. This happened in Kashmir in the middle of 2010 when even the military might proved useless. The ruling class is fast developing a fascist temper. Its hatred of the underclass is very visible. If so India will break into pieces.

India was never a "nation". And it will never be. This country of class, caste, tribes, religions and hundreds of languages and ethnic cleavages will simply break up—forcing some powerful neighbours to step in and rule India.

This habit of relying on the corrupt stock market, bankers, financial experts, economists, who all over the world have proved to be frauds during the recent financial collapse, will only lead the country to bigger and bigger crisis.

Political leadership has been co-opted by the Brahminical rulers who are projecting their *jatwala* "financial experts" as the new saviour. This is the real danger.

Stock market racketeers

For your information such world famous Western TV networks like the BBC, CNN, Euro never, ever report on the Indian stock market because for them India is of no significance. But what actually is happening in the Indian stock market run by the Gujarati Banias and their corrupt caucus and aided by the more corrupt Indian Brahminical "financial experts"?

Not even 2% of the Indian population (about 1,300 million)

has anything to do with the stock market. This writer has not a single share in any company.

Yet this less than 2% of the stock market racketeers decide the fate of the country. Everybody's eyes (meaning those who matter in India) are fixated on the share market. The share market ups and downs decide the decision of the govt. This is the danger

Dalal Street Dagalbajis

Those holding shares are mostly the English-knowing urban dwellers. From this we can make out how the fate of the over 1,300 million people in this vast subcontinent is decided by a micro-minority — mostly Banias and Brahmins and their camp followers.

It is this stock market that shapes our policies, our very future. Certainly not the over 85% of the people living outside — and certainly not the producers of food. See the power of the Dalal Street *Dagalbajis* and the mindmanipulating *Manuwadis*. And all those involved (official and non-officials mostly in the world of high finance like banking and allied activities) are the stinking corrupt lot.

Corrupt financial journalists

It is these people along with those equally corrupt journalists connected with financial newspapers and TV — whose business it is to keep the country ever optimistic — putting out periodical false reports saying the real estate market "has started picking up", "tourism is booming", "exports are soaring"." India's GDP jumps to 8%". Utter falsehood. The unthinking urbanites consume this poison injected into their brains by the Brahminists and go gaga. The over 60% illiterate and semi-illiterate dumbdriven sweat labour are totally ignorant of this urban drama of the educated elite.

Financial journalists are all under instruction to put out only false news even as things go on simply collapsing and dying. Newspapers and TV keep on painting a rosy picture of optimism. This exactly was the philosophy behind the "India Shining" gimmick of the *Brahmana Jati Party* (BJP) election stunt that refused to pay dividend.

All revolutionaries were pessimists

The only paper in India which comes out with a truthful picture of the country is *Dalit Voice* but we are dubbed prophets of doom. Always talking negative, finding fault with everything and thereby misleading the people. That means these "educated", particularly the English educated elite, are made to believe only the falsehood.

Those who run down DV must know that not a single prophecy made in DV has gone wrong. All our statements are in black and white and hence verifiable.

The charge against DV is we are for ever pessimists. We accept this charge.

All the greatest philosophers and path-finders who figure in world history right from the Budha, Karl Marx, Mao, Prophet Mohammed, Dr. Ambedkar, Periyar EVR were pessimists.

India's intellectual desert

Gandhi was a perpetual optimist and led us to doom and disaster. Revolutionaries **have** to be pessimists. Then only he or she would goad the people to fight for social change. Optimists produce crooks and crackpots.

Look at the deep wound such a psyche will inflict upon the country's morale. The educated people of India should have been the harbingers of change and leaders of thought-revolution which precedes all other varieties of revolution.

Instead of the educated leading us, they are only misleading the country, blindly believing in the downright falsehood, which forces you to become dishonest, corrupt. When a society lacks even in basic honesty what will be its future?

Scholars dying

Scholars are dying, if not dead. The society has no respect for the learned, the intellectual. Those adored and paraded are the bogus Brahminists who survive on the *masala* of media moles.

Book-shops are closing down. Libraries gathering dust. University professors are paid agents of politicians. Hindu India has turned into a vast intellectual Sahara.

If you have tears shed them now.

That is how the entire Indian elite society — you take any branch of this society, even our academia and intellectual world not spared — has become rotten to the core, stinking, nauseating.

The charge against Dalit Voice

Our teachers, called the noblest profession, have lost all respect. Nobody likes to go to the teaching field. That is how only those who don't get any other job become teachers. (V.T. Rajshekar, *India's Intellectual Desert*, DSA-1999, Rs. 50).

The moment we say this we are called pessimistic, prophets of doom and gloom. "The Editor of DV has no other business except to run down India, criticise our own

country in the public and present a bad image of it to foreigners".

What is the meaning of this charge against us? It only means that we should not speak out the Truth and uphold Justice. Is supporting Justice and Truth — the very foundation on which any society has to be built if it has to bloom — a crime? Yes. This is the Brahminical microminority charge against us.

Master crook Chanakya

This is the charge of a set of people who consider Chanakya (Kautilya) of the *Arthasastra*, the work of a master crook, as a genius.

Such master crooks may be in a micro-minority, say less than 15% of our population, but alas they are our rulers today — parading as *Deshbhaktas* — with a stranglehold on our neck. They set the values which have not only ruined the whole elite society but also its children — and the country as a whole. This is the problem we face today.

Honestly, we don't know where we are heading. There is not one single voice in this country except DV which echoes such sentiments. Why? Because speaking out the Truth and defending Justice is not popular. It will not be appreciated.

Are there no "good Brahmins"?

Yes. We do meet some "good Brahmins". As we discuss these problems, the "good Brahmin" nods his head. He does not disagree. But when we ask him why he is not raising his voice against the thugs and pindaries pillaging the society, he sulks. Silent.

That is why Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar said "Brahmins of India have not produced a single revolutionary". The most

important quality of a revolutionary is he/she must be a very angry person. Angry against the system.

Kanshi Ram's anger

Kanshi Ram once physically attacked a group of Brahminical journalists stealthily hiding in the garden of his Khan Market official residence (Delhi) in the dead of night as he came home from a meeting. He showed us the spot where the "rascals" were hiding and how he and his bodyguards gave them a first class dressing down. We congratulated him and said such direct action was better than a thousand words.

Look at the cut-throat quarrel of the Ambani brothers' corrupt caucus. Both are crooks. Yet there is none to discipline them. All the journalists are on their pay roll.

That doesn't mean the country as a whole is rotting. No. No. No.

Producers of food are good people

The overwhelming village-dwelling people, even those in small towns, are pure, clean — with deep interest of the country at heart. Why? Because they are producers,

All producers of food are good people. Crooks and criminals live mainly in big cities. It is these producers of wealth who have the genuine interest of the country at heart. But who bothers about them?

Contempt for farmers

But the problem is the villagers, particularly the farmers, do not command respect in our society. In America, England, Japan, Europe etc. the farmers are held in high esteem. But in Hindu India even a village girl is not ready to marry a farmer. Because farming is held in great

contempt. Brahminical values have percolated deep down even into villages.

To repeat, village-dwelling people are producers of wealth. The proof of their work is all there before our very eyes — what we eat and drink — foodgrains, fish, meat, fruits and vegetables, milk, oil etc. The paper on which we write comes from villages,. Even the dress we wear is made from cotton, wool, silk, leather. The alcohol, which the *Bhoodevatas* love, is made from village products. None can live without food. Our urban merry-makers are so fond of eating and drinking and yet they are very fond of ridiculing the village-dwelling farmers. What do these urban, hate-mongering parasites produce? Gossip, rumours, lies, scandals, brain-washing, character assassination, cheating, cheap jokes, wife-beating, show business, all sorts of crimes.

Cockroaches

They love everything that is Western, particularly USA, without following a single great quality of the Americans who made it the sole super power. Our elite society is producing only worms and cockroaches.

It is true that our villages are the sink of caste politics. Dr. Ambedkar has said it. The caste is in tact in the villages. That doesn't mean the cities are free from caste. Not at all.

Educated people are more caste conscious than the village-dwelling caste leaders.

Cross-thread journalists

Villages are caste-ridden and the Untouchables are the worst sufferers of the caste. This is true.

Caste as an institution is alive and kicking in the village

but being engaged as producers they do not take their casteism to extremes — except in very rare cases.

But in urban areas, which are also divided caste-wise, caste is the deciding factor in every aspect of life. In the Bangalore Press Club, fully under Brahminical control, its election is fought on caste basis.

Look at our different financial institutions, all urban-based. You will see them loaded with just one single "supreme" caste. Every selection of a post is done on caste basis. The Supreme Court of India is packed with the upper castes. Our Army is totally caste-based. Chartered accountants, who assist all corrupt industrialists and businessmen to evade taxes, are mostly Brahmins. The temple *archaka* (priest) post is reserved for one single caste and the Supreme Court itself upheld it. The urban India is top to bottom caste-based and the monopoly of the arrogant Aryan. The journalistic profession is the monopoly of the cross-thread *walas*.

Mala-Madiga dispute

Muslims, who are mostly urbanites, are the worst victims of the other side of the caste coin — communalism.

Villages no doubt are divided on caste basis, segregated on caste basis. Yes. This is a historical development. Yet agriculture production proceeds with collective effort. The rural caste leads to casteism which promotes hatred resulting in caste clashes and violence. This is true.

During the height of the Mala-Madiga dispute in Andhra Pradesh the enemity was confined only to Hyderabad and big urban areas. It did not percolate to villages where the Mala-Madigas, who live side by side, had perfect peace.

JNU as hot bed of casteism

Caste is there in villages but caste (identity) is different from casteism which is bad and dangerous. (V.T. Rajshekar, *Caste — A Nation Within the Nation*, Books for Change, 2002).

It is the educated people who are the highly caste conscious. To verify the truth go to the country's most famous Jawaharlal Nehru University in the heart of Delhi. Brahminism decides everything in JNU. Anti-Mandal war and violence was planned, plotted in the JNU. The worst sufferers are the Dalits and Muslim students. This is so in all our 200 and odd universities. If the country's very temple of learning is casteist and corrupt who can save the country?

Anti-Muslim riots planned in cities

All anti-Muslim and even caste war and violence are plotted in cities. Caste-riots may erupt in some villages but soon it dies down and the warring castes live peacefully for decades. The Gujjar-Meena violent clashes in Rajasthan erupted twice and soon cooled down. The two are now living peacefully.

That is how the *Brahmana Jati Party* (BJP) rarely gets vote from rural areas. BJP is an urban phenomenon.

It is the educated, mostly the English-educated people — cream of the country (forming about 15%) — who are killing democracy and subverting the very constitution of India. To these heaven-born privileged class social justice is the most hated poison pill. That is why they have virtually killed it. And the very Supreme Court of India, which is charged with the task of upholding and interpreting the constitution, has conspired in killing social justice.

Doctors become blood-suckers

See how the Brahminical mind manipulators and braintwisters — who are projected as our role model whose pictures are front-paged — have ruined the morale of the different professions. Particularly the doctors — called the noblest of all professions. Today the doctors have become blood-suckers, with minor exceptions. Big hospitals have turned into pickpockets. Same is the case with the profession of lawyers.

Scotch whisky & chicken kabab

Journalists are no longer interested in the villages. Each journalist is on the pay roll of a politician or an industrialist. Scotch whisky with chicken kabab will produce a handsome report. Businessmen anyway are crooks. Politicians wholesale corrupt. Who is left? Exceptions are there but exceptions prove the rule.

Corruption flows from top to bottom

We do admit corruption at the lower level: police constables, clerks in all govt. offices — all such last and the least tail-enders — are also corrupt. But corruption flows from top to bottom — not bottom to top. Not viceversa. We can't blame the constable when the IGP-DGP are stinking. We can't blame the court clerk when the judge passes order on the basis of the dollars credited to his Swiss Bank account.

India may be the world's most corrupt country. Yes it is. But it begins from the Prime Minister.

Money corruption is a small part of the overall world of corruption. The most dangerous form of corruption is the intellectual corruption.

We have dealt with this subject elaborately in our book, India's Intellectual Desert (DSA-1999). When intellectuals of a society start stinking — the rest start rotting. This is Hindu India today.

Our "educated" people are destroying the country itself — all our good old value system. The cream of the country's English-educated society (read the Brahminical upper castes) are fleeing the country (good riddance to bad rubbish), cursing it and joining mostly American universities and settling down there. Good. The "Jews of India" are busy conspiring with their cousins (Jews). But the problem is even while sitting in distant America and Britain they are subverting India to impose their Brahminical dictatorship.

We don't know what will happen to the country, particularly its up and coming "educated youth" encouraged to pursue perverse vocations.

The only hope comes from the Dalits and the Bahujan Samaj, which is mainly a village-dwelling lot, but they are also getting Brahminised.
