### RIDDLE NO.5

WHY DID THE BRAHMINS GO FURTHER AND DECLARE THAT THE VEDAS ARE NEITHER MADE BY MAN NOR BY GOD ?

The Vedic Brahmins were not content with investing the Vedas with infallibility. They went further and asserted that the Vedas were *Apaurusheya*. By this they meant the Vedas were not made by man. This doctrine no doubt leads to the doctrine of Infallibility. For not being made by man they are free from the failings, faults and frailties of man and are therefore infallible. All the same it is necessary to examine the theory separately for it is an independent theory:

Is there really no human author of the Vedas? Are they really *Apaurusheya*? The best evidence on the subject is the evidence of the *Anukramanis* — a special class of literature which forms part of the ancient Sanskrit literature. What are called *Anukramanis* are nothing but systematic indices to various portions of the ancient Vedic literature. Every Veda has an *Anukramani*, sometimes have more than one *Anukramani*, Seven *Anukramanis* for the Rig Veda are known to be in existence, five by Shaunaka, one by Katyayana and one by an unknown author. For the Yajur Veda there exist three *Anukramanis*, one for each of the three Shakhas, Atreyi, Charayaniyas and Madhyandina. For the Sama Veda there are two *Anukramanis*, one is called *Arsheya-Brahmana* and the other is known by the name of *Parishistas*. As to the Atharva Veda, one *Anukramani* is known to exist. It is known as *Brihat-Sarvanukramani*.

The most perfect *Anukramani*, according to Prof. Max Muller, is Katyayana's *Sarvanukramani* to the Rig Veda. Its importance lies in the fact that it gives (1) the first words of each hymn, (2) the number of verses, (3) the name and the family of the rishi who composed it, (4) the names of the deities and (5) the metres of every verse. What emerges from a reference to the *Sarvanukramani* is that the **Rishis are the authors of the hymns which make up the Rig Veda**. The Rig Veda therefore on the evidence of the *Anukramani* cannot but be regarded as a **man-made work**. The

same must be the conclusion regarding the other Vedas.

That the *Anukramanis* are realistic is proved by many passages in the Rig Veda in which the Rishis describe themselves as the composers of the hymns.

"The Kanvas make a prayer to you, hear well their invocation. Thus O, Indra, yoker of steeds, have the Gotamas made hymns for these efficaciously."

This hymn has efficaciously been made to you, O opulent Asvins, by the Manas".

"These magnifying prayers, (this) hymn, O Asvins, the Gritsamadas have made for you".

"Aspiring to heaven, the sage Kusikas have made a hymn with praises to thee, O Indra".

"Nodhas, descendant of Gotama, fashioned this new hymn for (thee), Indra, who are of old, and who yoked thy seeds".

"Thus O, hero, have the Gritsamadas, desiring succour, fashioned for thee a hymn as men make works".

"The sages generated an efficacious production and a prayer for Indra".

"These hymns, Agni, generated for thee, celebrate thy bounty in cows and horses".

"Our father hath discovered (or invented) this great, seven-headed hymn, born of sacred truth; Ayasya, friend of all men celebrating Indra, has generated the fourth song of praise".

"We, the Raghuanas, have uttered to Agni honied speech; we incessantly laud him with eulogies".

"Thus, all ye Adityas, Aditi, and ye ruling powers, has the wise son of Plati magnified you. The celestial race has been lauded by the immortal Gaya".

"He it is whom they call a rishi, a priest, a pious sacrificer a chanter of prayers, a reciter of hymns, he it is who knows the three bodies of the brilliant (Agni), the man who is most prominent in bestowing gifts".

# Sikh leader fears defeat for Brahminism if India confronts China

That the judiciary, including the highest court, is not above suspicion is well known. Not only the judges, even the Supreme Court top lawyers.

Shanti Bhushan has named the corrupt CJS and many of them are Brahmins. Corruption is not the monopoly of any caste but the *Bhoodevatas* are leaders in this field also.

## KALMADI CORRUPTION

The whole world is shocked by the Brahmin culprit Kalmadi's corruption in the Commonwealth Games. But we are not.

Because it is not possible in "Hindu India" to exist without being corrupt.

The problem we face in India is we always have different meaning to every act.

## DEFENDING MANU'S LAW

When a person is accused of corruption, what we mean is "money corruption". But we have said in our book, *India's Intellectual Desert* (DSA-1999, Rs. 50) that money corruption is the last and the least dangerous of the four forms of corruption. "Intellectual corruption" is the most dangerous form of the four.

A Supreme Court sitting judge recently delivered in Bangalore three lectures on a working day at Brahminical institutions on different aspects of Brahminical law. And fully defending it. When the country and

its SC are governed by the constitution how could this Brahmin judge uphold the hated anti-human law of Manu?

## BRIBE-GIVER IS ALSO CORRUPT

**Nobody criticised this judge's conduct in defending Manu which is more dangerous than crores of corruption.**

There is yet another important side to the "corruption stories" which always get front-page publicity. Why the readers love "corruption stories", like to see corrupt fellows pictures and punished by the law of the land?

An official, judge or a minister takes money. And this is called corruption.

But did we ever think that the "corrupt fellow" took the bribe because it was willingly given to him by the interested party? Then why don't we criticise the bribe-giver? Without the bribe-giver how can there be a bribe-taker? Both are too sides of the same coin.

## TEMPLE CORRUPTION

In this Brahminical India there is no single govt. dept., central or state, which is not corrupt. It is top to bottom. Corruption begins from the top. Not the bottom.

It is also wrong to say that corruption is confined to only govt. sector. The private sector is equally corrupt. All private education institutions collect heavy capitation fees — all unaccounted. Private hospitals, loot the patients.

All shops cheat the customers with faulty weighing machines. Drug stores dispense spurious medicines. Taxis and autos cheat people. There is no place without corruption.

**What about temple corruption?**

**Yes. The list of bribe amount is displayed at the very entrance. All auditors bribe income tax officers. Traders avoid paying tax. Liquor stores sell adulterated stuff.**

Cricket is top to bottom corrupt.

Newspapers and journals resort to all sorts of corruption. If you give Scotch and chicken *tikka* you will get a good report.

## WORST CORRUPT COUNTRY IN WORLD

Every Press Club in big cities get big money from the powers-to be. "Paid News" is the latest corruption charge against the daily papers. Even the Press Commission is trying to hush up the crime.

In another two years newspapers will have to devote almost every page to report corruption stories.

**You will be shocked to hear even village voters have started demanding money for votes. That means our Brahminical system has made even the people corrupt.**

The top in every branch of the society is corrupt. Those in the bottom are watching and learning. India will then become the worst corrupt in the world.

## HARSHAD MEHTA & BAL THACKERAY

Who is not corrupt in India?

**Our very system itself is corrupt. Our entire socio-economic-cultural-political machinery has become totally corrupt.**

Harshad Mehta was not a govt. servant. Bal Thackeray, sitting on a mountain of money today, too was never in govt. Our Dalal Street *Dagalbajis* are not govt. servants.

**The Kanchi Shankarachari not**

**getting any conviction despite his proven scandals and murders is neither a govt. servant nor a politician.**

The whole lot is corrupt. Our very system is corrupt.

The Christian church, the Muslim *masjid*, the Sikh gurdwaras are not above corruption.

#### ARMY GENERAL SENTENCED

The No.2 man in the Army is today facing court martial for corruption. We saw the army corruption in the purchase of coffins when George Fernandes was the Defence Minister.

**To repeat: Our very system itself is corrupt — rotten. The "Khatri Sick" PM himself defended CW Games corruption.**

What is this system?

#### GLORIFYING THE RICH

This system glorifies the rich. Ambanis are praised and paraded. They are always front-paged. Why the people "respect" the Ambanis even when they don't pay the tax? Why the papers always front-page news of "India's richest"? Because we silently admire the rich and would like to emulate them.

Get-rich-quick is the advice given to every youth by the father and mother.

About 20 years ago the parent wished his son to study well and lead a happy life.

#### HOW TO MAKE MONEY?

Now, this has changed.

**The common talk is: "Do you know so and so is doing very well?" What he means by that "wellness" is the fellow has made pots of money. But nobody asks how he has made that money.**

Nobody is interested in knowing it. So when the rich are glamourised, praised and paraded, get front page in *Times of India*, our value system

changes. We aim at making money by hook or crook.

But making money is the easiest. You must have no scruples, no principles. Cheat, rob, bribe or take bribe, resort to any means including murder — you become rich. And once you become rich you become the Ambani. Your past is quickly forgotten. And get all awards, rewards. Front-page pictures, TV interviews, Rotary Club honour.

Your wife, mother, father will all love you, run after you only if you are rich.

#### DESPISED BY FAMILY

This writer is the eldest in the family and yet the poorest. The family is not interested in our intellectual attainments. Who is interested in all this useless things? "All his brothers and sisters live in their own bungalows but this fellow lives in a rented house and always clad in a *jungli* dress". This is how we are ridiculed.

Look at the value system of the society. It honours, loves, adores only the rich. So the natural rush to make money and be known to the society as a *crorepati*.

Our value system has changed. It does not give any mark to your character, values, intellectual attainments, your work and suffering for social change. Nothing.

#### CORRUPTION IS KILLING INDIA

In a temple, no poor man is allowed inside. Only the one who comes in a big car with pots of money to the "god" (meaning the priest) gets the first preference.

**The god also respects the rich.**

What is the point in blaming the Supreme Court CJs? Poor fellows. They are all victims of the socio-cultural system that governs this Brahminical society.

The whole thing is sickening.

**That is why nothing in India is**

**progressing. Nothing in India is moving. Corruption is killing India.**

CW Games is the best proof. The whole country has become one vast CW Games village. (See p.3 Edit)

Our entire traffic, railways, police system, banks, education, health system — are all cracking, collapsing.

#### "KHATRI SICK" PM

The "Khatri Sick" is called India's most "honest PM". But just because he is not taking bribes (we do not know it) does not mean he is not corrupt.

Corruption is not "money corruption" alone. We have explained this in our book, *India's Intellectual Desert*.

**Corrupt thoughts are more dangerous than mere money corruption. The "Khatri Sick's" thoughts itself are corrupt. A World Bank (Jewish-owned) nominee, he is supporting the "Jews of India" blindly. Is it not corruption?**

Over 150 stone-pelting students were fired at and killed in Kashmir. Amnesty International has taken serious objection to this action but the country's ruling class is fully backing this PM. Our ruling class is itself corrupt to the core and this corruption is spreading deep into villages. Dangerous days are ahead.

As the PM, he is responsible for every action of the govt. All the actions of the govt under him are in favour of the rich who in India are none but the upper castes (15%). It is only after he took over, more Indians were pushed below the poverty line.

#### DALIT CHRISTIANS

**Money corruption is the last and the least dangerous part of the over all world of corruption.**

The church (both Catholic and

What is needed is not a drive to curb corruption but to destroy the very value system that prompts you to become corrupt. But the value system comes mostly from the religion. Who is ready to touch the religion?

May be the Brahminical India will rot, stink and degenerate — until another foreign invader comes and takes over.

China stands a good chance. ■

2. It is wrong to say that the problem of the Untouchables is a social problem.
3. The problem of the Untouchables is fundamentally a political problem.  
(Dr. B.R. Ambedkar: *What Congress & Gandhi Have Done to the Untouchables*, Thacker & Co. Ltd., Bombay, 1945, p.182).
4. The Untouchables feel that their title deeds to humanity — which means — their emancipation from their thralldom of the Hindus — can be secured by them by political power, and by nothing else. (Ibid p.253).
5. Having put his programme to test, Mr. Gandhi might have shown his willingness to concede the

Untouchables demand for political power as their only means of salvation. Indeed so obvious is the justice of this demand that a man with no more than common sense could have understood that executive power in the hands of the Untouchables could do more in a year than the whole order of preaching friars could be relied upon to do in a century". (Ibid p.254).

The above quotations are original. We cannot rely on second or third hand quotations on such fundamental issues. Capture of political power is primary. Educate, Agitate and Organize (to capture political power) is the process. The Bahujan leadership of different regions in the Indian subcontinent has to work out the details as to whom to/why to/when to educate and what sort of education/awareness.

The villagers (70%) are angry saying: "We don't want your free literature and speeches. Tell us whom to vote to better our lives". They are agitated without being educated. We are forced to re-think on "Educate". What is our answer? ■

(1) Brother Kovena has been sincerely working on the job of "capturing political power" based on the quotations he cited from Dr. Ambedkar's books. We are not disputing it. But what is the progress he achieved in the past 30 years?

(2) Mayawati has been the CM of UP for three times. She has the "political power" but has she been able to bring about a "socio-

## Thus Spake Periyar

### HISTORY OF VAIKOM AGITATION

#### Note on Vaikom

Vaikom is a beautiful small town in the Kerala State. Formerly, it was under the Travancore State, ruled by kings.

Till 1924, the "low caste" men were not allowed to walk in the streets, near the temple as they would "pollute" it by their walking according, to the evil caste-system of Brahmins.

Thanthai Periyar E.V. Ramasami, the fighter for human rights, and eradication of Untouchability, participated in the agitation to throw open the streets for "low caste" Ezhavas, organised by George Joseph and others. He courted imprisonment twice and won their rights.

Fittingly, Periyar is called the "Hero of Vaikom".

Periyar recalls his experiences in the year 1958 at a public meeting in Kanyakumari District.

Respectful President,

Ladies and gentlemen,

I was extended an invitation to come over to the Kanyakumari District many times by your comrades. As I was busily touring in other districts, I could not come earlier. Wherever I toured, I found a great awakening. People gathered in thousands.

Ten years ago, I addressed a meeting here in Marthandam. In those days you were citizens of a Native State. You were ruled by a Rajah, where as we were citizens of British Government. Yet we are all "sudras" (heirs of prostitutes). **We Dravidians were subjected to humiliation by the Brahmins.** It was the outcome of the hoax played on us, we continue to be "sudras".

Today, we are citizens of one country. We are Tamilians of Tamilnadu. We are today brought together. Our unity is strengthened. We are today linked as one family because we are all, now citizens of one country. We have to work together for achieving our ideals as we are all classified under one caste. So far as I am concerned, I led the agitation even some 35 years ago in Tamilnadu to eradicate the social evils particularly the hateful

untouchability. For over thousand years we were not allowed to enter some of the public roads. Those who are now aged at least 50 years may recollect those days. Youngsters of this generation may not know these things of the past.

If there had not been the agitation in those days, today many of us would not have the right to pass through many of the roads. In those days conditions were very bad in this country. **The Government was in the hands of the orthodox Brahmins.** The *Varnashrama Dharma* was in its full sway. In our country, the advent of the non-Brahmin movement, redeemed a number of rights to the Non-Brahmins. The Non-Brahmin Movement successfully combated the Brahmin domination. That Non-Brahmin Movement was popularly known as the Justice Party; named after its journal "Justice".

The Brahmins too had their own organisations as Brahmana Samajam, and Brahmana Mahasabha. They worked against our interests and stood in the way of our attaining many of our legitimate rights. Brahmins were proud of calling themselves as "Highest caste". They insisted on calling themselves as Brahmins. Many law and other sastras too termed us as "sudras" only. What an amount of humiliation and degradation we were subjected to.

If we do not opt for the name of Dravidar Kazhagam or Tamilar Kazhagam, we have to choose only "Sudra" Kazhagam, as the suitable name for our organisation.

That is why, we had to change the name of the South Indian Liberal Federation, later called as the Justice Party, as the Dravidar Kazhagam, to make ourselves known to the world as to who we are. The Dravidians are people of a proud nation, known to the world.

On account of the efforts taken by the Non-Brahmin Movement (Justice Party) in the years 1919 and 1920 and the agitations in Tamilnadu, the right to make use of all roads irrespective of castes we got, not only in Tamilnadu but also in Andhra, Karnataka and Kerala.

## Editor kept aloof from masses

I am DV member since one year. I feel it is my duty to share my views with a great Ambedkarite scholar like V.T. Rajshekar on "Closing down DV". I have tried to find out the reasons behind the downfall of DV.

Various suggestions have been given by the DV members. All serious and intellectual members will remain with DV.

DV members are simply readers. At the most you have made them intellectuals through DV. They are not cadre-based or organized activists. So how can we expect from them a disciplined response?

Those who are only "educated" since 30 years, but not "organized", are not ready to "agitate", do not respond, do not react to any appeal that you made.

**Our people don't read even Mahatma Phule, Babasaheb, Periyar. How can we expect them to read your books for deeper study?**

I don't agree with your interpretation of Babasaheb and Kanshi Ram's mass movement. There is vast difference between running a media and building mass movement. Various organizations and scholars pretend that they are the only Ambedkarites but they don't have any programme, agenda, action plan; cadre-based organization to fulfil Babasaheb's dream.

**Politics is must:** The Sangha established by Budha, Satya Shodhak Movement of Mahatma Phule, Bahishkrit Hitkarni Sabha, Independent Labour Party, All India Scheduled Caste Federation of Babasaheb, Periyar E.V. Ramaswamy's Dravida Kazaghama (DK), Kanshi Ram's BAMCEF, DS4 and BSP are all mass movements fought for Bahujana, which did large-scale awakening and agitation for liberation of masses but VTR remained aloof from masses since last 30 years.

How can we discard politics from social and cultural life? Are they not co-related, and influence each other? Kanshi Ram did not jump into politics all of a sudden but it was a journey from the working class union to the social movement and to the political movement.

**VTR no doubt provided an intellectual platform where the people can collectively analyse and articulate relevant issues and problems. But this forum is not united, organized to solve the problems or march towards the goal of Phule-Ambedkarite ideology of building Mulniwasi Bharat**

**Rashtra. Yes, we have our media but where is the movement? After 30 years of work, you haven't organized a single activist who will accompany you towards achieving the goal. They have just become a devotee and a devotee can't be revolutionary.**

**Educated are unreliable:** Masses respond only to charity (god) and mass leader (revolutionary), for their liberation. The words of intellectuals, scholars do not appeal them. A missionary never fails. Casteism is a mental slavery. The slave tries to defend and protect it. Bahujans out of their ignorance cling strengthen and preserve the very system which degrades them. The so-called educated people are not "socially educated", hence they continue to be the same.

The Editor is aware of the history that the educated people are unreliable. Still you have wasted your 30 years in awakening these 3%. Why? Instead of that why didn't you go direct to masses and start working for them?

**Media centre:** The Editor has been emphasizing on "media centre" in Delhi which is the only hope for revolution in India. Otherwise, you predicted there will be final "Sunset on the Dalit world". Closing down DV and death of DV means the slow death of India. Ambedkarite movement is the movement of equality, liberty and fraternity against the inhuman system of inequality, injustice, discrimination based on the casteism (racism).

The magnitude of the problem is so serious that the efforts are highly inadequate. A media can definitely contribute in association with a nationwide Bahujan movement.

But how can only a print media bring about revolution? It is like thinking of winning a war on paper without fighting. What is needed is movement.

*Dalit Voice* is the fearless Ambedkarite journal which has national and international circulation. It should **organize** national and international Dalit intellectuals to fulfill Dr. Babasaheb's mission. DV can be like the RSS, an ideologue and strategy-determining centre of power of Brahmins. We (DV family) can form such a centralized non-political organization to propagate Dr. Babasaheb's mission of humanity, with a vision of forming Bahujan India.

India has not seen an English or even a language journal of Dalits lasting 30 years.

### AFRAID OF BRAHMIN BOSSES

The situation of the country and DV in particular is not as simple as he describes. Babasaheb himself on his death bed had said the educated sections of his community have cheated him. This is proved from the communications from different parts of India published in DV.

Serving IAS/IPS officers keep away from DV and the community. Not because DV is not speaking the Truth and supporting Justice but because they are afraid of their Brahmin bosses.

### RACIST CHIEF JUSTICE

But even the lowest ranking Brahmin in a govt. office will courageously celebrate festivals of his gods in the office itself — and that too during the office hours. None dare question him. They openly attend RSS shakhas and all subversive activities.

A Brahmin on taking over as the Chief Justice of Allahabad High Court got the "holy

waters" from the Ganga and got his chair "cleaned" because its previous occupant, a Dalit, had polluted it. The entire High Court staff had silently witnessed it. The shocking incident was also reported in the press. No Brahmin took objection to the racist behaviour of the Chief Justice.

Jitendra stresses "political power". Fine. BSP has been in "political power" in UP but the power of the Brahmin, Vaishya, Thakurs of UP are in tact not only in the society but even in the govt. What use is this "political power"?

### MONEY POURS INTO BRAHMIN COFFERS

"Educate" is the first of the "Three Commandments" of Babasaheb. DV strictly confines to that. That is the job we took upon ourselves. We can't combine all the three and mess up the things. We have explained the significance of Babasaheb's "Three Commandments" in our book.

**Our own family members suffer from so much of confusion and become argumentative without offering to support us in this critical time.**

Look at the money that pours into the coffers of Brahmin temples — in crores. The entire money flows into the Brahminical subversive activities.

But when we run a journal,

acknowledged by the whole readership as the right, real Voice of the Bahujans, and a big debate is going on, the total money that poured in is a merely Rs. 4 lakhs.

What a shame.

Just imagine how weak we are.

### UNTHINKING OBCs

OBCs (35%) are an unthinking community. We have hardly any circulation among them — though we always fought and suffered for them. Muslims are another problem. They are a problem even to themselves. The Christian church is controlled by its Brahmin converts (Syrians). Sikhs are busy quarreling.

### DALITS AS LEADERS OF BAHUJANS

Despite all this indifference of the OBCs and religious minorities, we stood by them. Only because the Bahujans are our people. And Babasaheb said Dalits are the natural leaders of the Bahujan.

Tribals are under the deepest darkness.

In spite of such hostile surroundings and indifference of the "educated" sections among Dalits, DV survived for 30 years.

Jitendra Jadhav and his ilk must ponder over this — EDITOR.

## "THREE COMMANDMENTS" MISQUOTED

Even in your conference pamphlets

Inaugural speech at the Karnataka state BAMCEF conference in Bangalore

you have misquoted the "Three Commandments" of Babasaheb. What he said was "Educate, Agitate, Organise". But you have put "Organise" in the middle.

We call this as Babasaheb's "Three Commandments", but you must know that the three weapons given to us by Babasaheb are taken from Buddhism. They are "*Budham, Dhammam, Sangham*", which are Pali words.

## MEDITATION

Babasaheb borrowed it from Buddhism and called it "Educate, Agitate, Organise". Please correct this mistake as our enemy will use it and further confuse our people.

Some of our educated Dalits have interpreted *Dhammam* as "meditation". Babasaheb never did

meditation. Has anybody seen Babasaheb meditating? Does anybody have a photograph of Babasaheb doing meditation? In his book, *Buddha & His Dhamma*, he makes this clear.

## ART OF DECEIVING

Meditation has helped the Brahmins to capture our people, making them better slaves. We have in Bangalore a top fraud heading a multi-million dollar empire called the "Art of Deceiving". Instead of fighting the enemy, our educated Dalits have joined the enemy, wasting their precious time on meditation. Has Babasaheb done meditation? Has anybody seen him doing meditation? From where did our "educated" Dalits get the impression that Babasaheb did meditation? Meditation is for the ruling upper castes.

**However, I am happy to note that BAMCEF has not only identified the enemy but fiercely fighting. Congratulations. (cheers)**

Your pamphlet on "Introduction to BAMCEF" is wonderful.

## BRAHMINS & JEWS

It quotes an American professor saying that "the Brahmins are foreigners and that they are of Eurasian origin". You are right.

**In DV, we have made an extensive research and I have written two books saying the Brahmins and the Jews are blood brothers.**

Brahmins are misleading us saying that our enemies are the country's rich. This is the "class theory" of marxism which misled us for 30 years. Marxism is the other name for Brahminism.

In India, it is the Brahmins who

control the entire financial structure. I met a young Brahmin reading the *Wall Street Journal* in a London Hotel. I asked him why he was reading this paper. He said he wanted to enter the financial sector. Banking, stock exchange and market manipulation are the specialised field of Brahmins. In India, the Reserve Bank, which is the banker's bank and where currency notes are printed, is owned by the government. But in America, the Federal Reserve is a private bank whose office-bearers are all Jews. Though our RBI is government-owned, the Brahmins occupy all the top positions and posts in all the banks.

## BRAHMINS ARE EURASIANS

When you say that the Brahmins are Eurasians you are absolutely correct. Very rarely a Dalit organization has the courage to say this. Unless we **identify** the enemy whom are we going to fight? We cannot fight in the air. The enemy must be identified first. Babasaheb, Periyar and Phule all **identified** the enemy. But some Dalit organizations still have not done it. Once I attended a meeting in which one person said: "How long we must keep on criticizing the Brahmins? I think we must stop this. Brahmins are no longer our enemies". Look at our Dalit leaders buttering Brahmins.

## BRAHMINS & JEWS AS BLOOD BROTHERS

But see the position and the power the Brahmins hold in this country. In West Bengal, where the communists ruled for 30 years, the Chief Minister is a Brahmin. E.M.S. Namboodiripad, whom I knew intimately, was a 150% Brahmin. So the Brahmins control the Communist Party, the Congress Party and they have infiltrated into socialism and even Bahujan Samaj Party. They are everywhere. Where

there is sugar there will be ants. In *Dalit Voice*, we have written that the Brahmins and the Jews are blood brothers. We have to fight them.

## We have to be anti-Brahmin and anti-Brahminism.

In Maharashtra, every Chief Minister has been a Maratha. Yet the Marathas say they are backwards. The Marathas say that they need reservation. I visited Pune soon after the attack on Bhandarkar Oriental Research Institute by some Marathas. They are against Brahmins but not against Brahminism.

I will give you the example of Tamil Nadu. There was a Justice Party in Tamil Nadu led by the Mudaliars, the Reddys, and the Naidus. They said that non-Brahmins must get power. Because of the struggle of Periyar and DMK the non-Brahmins came to power in TN. After coming to power, however, they started kicking only our people.

**Today the Mudaliars, the Vellalas, the Naidus and the Chettiars are one with Brahmins.**

## EDUCATED DALITS BETRAYED THE COMMUNITY

In your pamphlet titled "Introduction to BAMCEF" (p.4), you say you are organising only the "educated class" and say the "educated class is nothing but the intellectual class". If this is true, this educated class should have carried out the mission of Babasaheb.

**Did they do it? I am sorry to say as the Editor of *Dalit Voice* the Dalit-educated class has disappointed us.**

Babasaheb himself said at the fag end of his life.

## GOVT. BABUS NOT INTELLECTUALS

The definition of an intellectual is one who earns his living out of his intellectual work. This class includes

writers, artists, teachers, singers, poets, teachers etc.

Govt. employees do not come under this class. Even journalists can't be strictly called intellectuals. They may be semi-intellectuals.

Yet in another place you say Dalit employees being govt. servants cannot participate in political activities.

You are wrong.

The Abhinav Bharat Brahmins who did the Malegaon bombing, now in jail, are all govt. servants. Some of them like Lt. Col. Srikanth Purohit are serving Army officers.

How did they actively participate in Malegaon anti-Muslim riots? How did they participate in political activities and become terrorists?

Participating in socio-cultural work is not political work. Lt. Col. Purohit's work in Malegaon anti-Muslim riots amounts to political work.

Sorry, please don't take my remarks as criticism of BAMCEF.

Though India signed the Human Rights Declaration, Dalits are not allowed to wear a new cloth, cannot grow mustache, cannot ride a horse in marriage procession, and cannot draw water from a common village well. He is not paid wages and asked to do free bonded labor and his children are, in the name of religion, sacrificed in front of deities.

### MAIN WEAPON OF BRAHMIN

**Theme of book:** In a country where majority of people have a religious belief that their present-day misery, poverty, disease, social position in caste structure and their lot in this life is because of their bad deeds in the previous lives, it is difficult to create self-respect and confidence in them.

understand all these points, the author created a character in his book, which can hardly be called a novel, though the structure is like that. He is 'Mahatma Dhan Sampati Maharaj' and represents the class with the vested interests. Story is all dialogues and the end is as mysterious as a novel of Agatha Chrishi.

### IDEOLOGY OF BHUDEVAS

Who is *Bhu-devata*? This Maharaj defines the *Bhu-devata* class as:

"Those who have the religious authority and sanction to utilize for their own use, the fruits of the toil of all toiling masses on the earth, are termed as *Bhu-devatas*."

In the eyes of Maharaj, it is not necessary to get worried if masses get educated, as long as higher education remains beyond the reach of masses. The constitution of the country is of no importance to them. According to the Maharaj, the republican method of governance is a system of deceiving people. In the lure of electoral position, masses do not even care to look after their own interest, let alone forming their own government.

The aim of the class the Maharaj represents is to quote the *avatars* and in the name of preservation of respect for nation and caste, to keep intact their own control over the lives of the people is their aim.

Even then they are a bit worried these days about the awakening that is taking place among the masses, and are getting busy in activities of treason and conspiracy against the masses. The purpose of this book is to make the masses aware of this mentality.

### ARYANS REPEATEDLY DEFEATED

The manners and customs of Hindus are based on certain elements in their history. That needs to be examined and analyzed under some philosophy to remove the evil influence on the masses.

It is the great tragedy of Indian history that all the governments established in this country after the reign of Asoka and Chandragupta Maurya, behaved with masses of this country as a victor-ruler would

### SUBJECTS DISCUSSED IN THE BOK

**Unwed Bhudeva mothers:** Among the audience, there was a young woman in early twenties, who had killed her child being an unwed mother and had become a *bairagin* (nun). The Maharaj admonishes her for killing her child and advises her that she should have stayed with the untouchable leader, father of the child, and put him to use to serve the *Bhudevatas*, without becoming one of them.

He quotes examples of many unwed daughters of *Bhudevatas*, who gave birth to children who became useful servants of *Bhudevatas*, like Karna, Jabala, Vyasa, Narada, etc. At the same time, he clarifies that the inter-caste marriages do not benefit the

lower castes as a whole and quotes examples of Dr. Ambedkar, Sarojini Naidu, Aruna Asaf Ali etc. The *bairagin* renounces her *ektara* etc. and feels happy to renounce the *japa of ram-naam*. Maharaj praises her beauty and advises her to go back to the world and help the youth of *Bhudevatas* who are working against the Untouchables and teach *ram-naam* to enemies to make them useless, without practicing it herself.

**Anti-cow slaughter law:** On the question of anti-cow slaughter law, he says, 'who says there is no such law in India, those who eat the beef, we change their religion. That provision is there in our constitution because it is secular and there is no ban on converting the Muslims to Hinduism.

**Secularism as temporary measure:** How secularism got incorporated in the Constitution? Were the *Bhudevatas* so scared of the Untouchables that they had to take recourse to secularism, when we had all our scriptures? The answer is, it was an temporary emergency measure.

## Manuwadi marxists bite Dalit writer

**Trivandrum:** The University Grants Commission has given approval to Dr. Chandra Mohanan S.R., Selection Grade Lecturer in English, Govt. Arts College, Trivandrum, for a research project, "Dalit literature in Kerala: Its philosophy and role in social and cultural integration", the first project of its kind in the state. As the work was in full swing, he was transferred and the project office closed.

Chandra Mohanan went to the High Court of Kerala when the Govt. Arts College principal refused to disburse the second instalment of the UGC aid to him.

The Court asked the govt. to consider Chandra Mohanan's request and transfer him back to Govt. Arts College, till the completion of the project. But the govt. said no. In July 2009, he was promoted principal

(ignoring the court order), and posted Principal, Govt. College, Manjeshwar, in the northern end of Kerala.

The court asked the govt. to accommodate him in the vacancy of Govt. Arts College, Trivandrum. But the govt. said Dr. Chandra Mohanan tenure as project ended on June 30, 2008.

**This is yet another case of Manuwadi marxists' anti-Dalit action.**

Chandra Mohanan was involved in the Democratic Government College Teacher's Association (DGCTA) which spearheaded Dalit Bahujan issues.

Dr. Chandra Mohanan has published a collection of Adivasi songs titled *Attapedi Adivasi Pattukal* (2007, DC Books). Another book, *Idukki Advasi Pattukal* is in print. ■

## Secret of India's poverty

**Bangalore:** India will not be able to solve its "problem of poverty" even after 50 years of MDG plan. This is the verdict of the United Nations.

But it did not say why.

**Who is ruling India:** In our book, *Who is Ruling India? And How?* (DSA-2010) we have said all this.

But what is the use of our book? English is known to only 3% of Indians of which 90% are Brahmins.

The country is collapsing — very fast.

The over-fed, arrogant rulers with a closed mind, fully

guided by the Jews in the West, are preparing for a war with Pakistan which will directly put India against China.

That means India will get further impoverished and lakhs of our people will die in the war. Who cares?

### UN indicts India

**New Delhi:** India will take over 50 years to halve its number of starving people due to low budget allocation for agriculture and rising food prices, a global report has said.

"India cannot halve its number of people starving until 2083, nearly 70 years after the Millennium Development goals target date", a report called "Who's Really Fighting Hunger?" said. Around a quarter of the world's population, who are deprived of food live in India and 43% of all children in the country under the age of five are malnourished, the study prepared by London-based organisation ActionAid says.

### Perception income

While India's per capita income tripled between 1990 and 2005, the number of hungry people also increased by 53 million bringing the total number of chronically hungry people in India to a staggering 270 million, it says.

According to a score-card mentioned in the documents, out of 28 nations ranked in the report, India got a dismal 21st rank while Brazil and China came first and second respectively. (*Deccan Herald*, Sept.19, 2010). ■

*The speech should bring tears because the "Father of India" alone was capable of posing such a question to the houseful of Big Brahmins.*

*Babasaheb stabbed in the back: The Brahminical rulers (15%) refused to solve even a single problem facing the Bahujans: their appalling poverty,*

*illiteracy, violence, caste discrimination, anti-Muslim riots and against Christians and Sikhs. The whole (85%) lot of Bahujans have been physically and mentally crushed. And yet our people, victim of Brahminism, are unmoved.*

*The educated, and employed SC/ST/BCs/Muslims, as leaders of the oppressed, should have become angry, furious and "blown up" the constitution.*

*But they cheated their own blood brothers and stabbed Babasaheb in the back. The poor man is today weeping in his Dadar Chowapatty grave.*

DR. AMBEDKAR'S FEARS

## Will India lose its independence & break into pieces

My mind is so full of the future of our country that I feel I ought to take this occasion to give expression to some of my reflections thereon. On 26th January 1950, India will be an independent country (*cheers*). What would happen to her independence? Will she maintain her independence or will she lose it again?

### HINDUS MAY INVITE MUSLIMS

This is the first thought that comes to my mind. It is not that India was never an independent country. The point is that she once lost the independence she had. Will she lose it a second time? It is this thought which makes me most anxious for the future. What perturbs me greatly is the fact that not only India has once before lost her independence, but she lost it by the infidelity and treachery of some of her own people. In the invasion of Sindh by Mahommed-Bin-Kasim, the military commanders of King Dahar accepted bribes from the agents of Mahommed-Bin-Kasim and refused to fight on the side of their king.

It was Jaichand who invited

Mahommed Ghori to invade India and fight against Prithvi Raj and promised him the help of himself and the Solanki kings. When Shivaji was fighting for the liberation of Hindus, the other Maratha noblemen and the Rajput Kings were fighting the battle on the side of Moghul Emperors. When the British were trying to destroy the Sikh Rulers, Gulab Singh, their principal commander sat silent and did not help to save the Sikh kingdom. In 1857, when a large part of India had declared a war of independence against the British, the Sikhs stood and watched the event as silent spectators.

### WILL HISTORY REPEAT ?

Will history repeat itself? It is this thought which fills me with anxiety. This anxiety is deepened by the realization of the fact that in addition to our old enemies in the form of castes and creeds we are going to have many political parties with diverse and opposing political creeds. Will Indians place the country above their creed or will they place creed above country? I do not know.

But this much is certain that if the parties place creed above country, our independence will be put in jeopardy a second time and probably be lost for ever. This eventuality we must all resolutely guard against. We must be determined to defend our independence with the last drop of our blood. (*cheers*).

### INDIA ONCE HAD THE BEST OF DEMOCRACY

On the 26th of the January 1950, India would be a democratic country in the sense that India from that day would have a government of the people, by the people and for the people. The same thought comes to my mind. What would happen to her democratic constitution? Will she be able to maintain it or will she lose it again. This is the second thought that comes to my mind and makes me as anxious as the first.

It is not that India did not know what is Democracy. There was a time when India was studded with republics, and even where there were monarchies, they were either elected or limited. They were never

absolute. It is not that India did not know parliaments or parliamentary procedure. A study of the Buddhist Bhikshu Sanghas discloses that not only there were Parliaments — for the Sanghas were nothing but Parliaments — but the Sanghas knew and observed all the rules of Parliamentary Procedure known to modern times. They had rules regarding seating arrangements, rules regarding Motions, Resolutions, Quorum, Whip, Counting of Votes, Voting by Ballot, Censure Motion, Regularisation, *Res Judicata*, etc. Although these rules of parliamentary procedure were applied by the Buddha to the meetings of the Sanghas, he must have borrowed them from the rules of the Political Assemblies functioning in the country in his time.

This democratic system India lost. Will she lose it a second time? I do not know, but it is quite possible in a country like India — where democracy from its long disuse must be regarded as something quite new — there is danger of democracy giving place to dictatorship. It is quite possible for this new born democracy to retain its form but give place to dictatorship in fact. If there is a landslide, the danger of the second possibility becoming actuality is much greater.

#### AVOID REVOLUTION

If we wish to maintain democracy not merely in form, but also in fact, what must we do? The first thing in my judgment we must do is to hold fast to constitutional methods of achieving our social and economic objectives. It means we must abandon the blood methods of revolution. It means that we must abandon the method of civil disobedience, non-cooperation and *satyagraha*. When there was no way left for constitutional methods for achieving economic and social objectives, there was a great deal of justification for

unconstitutional methods. But where constitutional methods are open, there can be no justification for these unconstitutional methods. These methods are nothing but the Grammar of Anarchy and the sooner they are abandoned, the better for us.

#### HERO WORSHIP

The second thing we must do is to observe the caution which John Stuart Mill has given to all who are interested in the maintenance of democracy, namely not "to lay their liberties at the feet of even a great man, or to trust him with powers which enable him to subvert their institutions". There is nothing wrong in being grateful to great men who have rendered life-long services to the country. But there are limits to gratefulness. As has been well said by the Irish Patriot Daniel O'Connell, "no man can be grateful at the cost of his honour, no woman can be grateful at the cost of her chastity and no nation can be grateful at the cost of its liberty". This caution is far more necessary in the case of India than in the case of any other country, for in India, Bhakti or what may be called the path of devotion or hero-worship, plays a part in its politics unequalled in magnitude by the part it plays in the politics of any other country in the world. Bhakti in religion may be a road to the salvation of the soul. But in politics, Bhakti or hero-worship is a sure road to degradation and to eventual dictatorship.

#### UNION OF TRINITY

The third thing we must do is not to be content with mere political democracy. We must make our political democracy a social democracy as well. Political democracy cannot last unless there lies at the base of it social democracy. What does social democracy mean?

It means a way of life which recognizes liberty, equality and

fraternity as the principles of life. The principles of liberty, equality and fraternity are not to be treated as separate items in a trinity. They form a union of trinity in the sense that to divorce one from the other is to defeat the very purpose of democracy. Liberty cannot be divorced from equality, equality cannot be divorced from liberty. Nor can liberty and equality be divorced from fraternity. Without equality, liberty would produce the supremacy of the few over the many. Equality without liberty would kill individual initiative. Without fraternity, liberty and equality could not become a natural course of things. It would require a constable to enforce them. We must begin by acknowledging the fact that there is complete absence of two things in Indian society. One of these is equality. On the social plane, we have in India a society based on the principle of graded inequality which means elevation for some and degradation for others. On the economic plane, we have a society in which there are some who have immense wealth as against many who live in abject poverty.

#### PROPHETIC WORDS

"On the 26th of January 1950, we are going to enter into a life of contradictions. In politics we will have equality and in social and economic life we will have inequality. In politics we will be recognizing the principle of one man one vote and one vote one value. In our social and economic life, we shall, by reason of our social and economic structure, continue to deny the principle of one man one value. How long shall we continue to live this life of contradictions? How long shall we continue to deny equality in our social and economic life? If we continue to deny it for long, we will do so only by putting our political democracy in peril. We must remove this

contradiction at the earliest possible moment or else **those who suffer from inequality will blow up the structure of political democracy** which this Assembly has so laboriously built up".

The second thing we are wanting in is recognition of the principle of fraternity. What does fraternity mean? Fraternity means a sense of common brotherhood of all Indians — if Indians being one people. It is the principle which gives unity and solidarity to social life. It is a difficult thing to achieve. How difficult it is, can be realized from the story related by James Bryce in his volume on American Commonwealth about the United States of America.

The story is — I propose to recount it in the words of Bryce himself — that:

#### INDIA NOT A NATION

"Some years ago the American Protestant Episcopal Church was occupied at its triennial convention in revising its liturgy. It was thought desirable to introduce among the short sentence prayers a prayer for the whole people, and an eminent New England divine proposed the words "O Lord, Bless our nation". Accepted one afternoon on the spur of the moment, the sentence was brought up next day for reconsideration, when so many objections were raised by the laity to the word "nation" as importing too definite a recognition of national unity, that it was dropped, and instead there were adopted the words "O Lord, bless these United States".

There was so little solidarity in the USA at the time when this incident occurred that the people of America did not think that they were a nation. If the people of the United States could not feel that they were a nation, how difficult it is for Indians to think that they are a nation. I remember the days when politically-minded Indians resented the

expression "the people of India". They preferred the expression "the Indian nation". I am of opinion that in believing that we are a nation, we are cherishing a great delusion. How can people divided into several thousands of castes be a nation? The sooner we realize that we are not as yet a nation in the social and psychological sense of the word, the better for us. For then only we shall realize the necessity of becoming a nation and seriously think of ways and means of realizing the goal. The realization of this goal is going to be very difficult — far more difficult than it has been in the United States.

The United States has no caste problem. In India there are castes. The castes are anti-national. In the first place because they bring about separation in social life. They are anti-national also because they generate jealousy and antipathy between caste and caste. But we must overcome all these difficulties if we wish to become a nation in reality. For fraternity can be a fact only when there is a nation. Without fraternity, equality and liberty will be no deeper than coats of paint.

#### CASTE SYSTEM KILLING INDIA

These are my reflections about the tasks that lie ahead of us. They may not be very pleasant to some. But there can be no gainsaying that political power in this country has too long been the monopoly of a few and the many are not only beasts of burden, but also beasts of prey. This monopoly has not merely deprived them of their chance of betterment, it has sapped them of what may be called the significance of life. These down-trodden classes are tired of being governed, they are impatient to govern themselves. This urge for self-realization in the down-trodden classes must not be allowed to develop into a class struggle or class war. It would lead

to a division of the House. That would indeed be a day of disaster. For, as has been well said by Abraham Lincoln, a house divided against itself cannot stand very long. Therefore the sooner room is made for the realization of their aspiration, the better for the few, the better for the country, the better for the maintenance for its independence and the better for the continuance of its democratic structure. This can only be done by the establishment of equality and fraternity in all spheres of life. That is why I have laid so much stress on them.

#### HINDUS WARNED

I do not wish to weary the House any further. Independence is no doubt a matter of joy. But let us not forget that this independence has thrown on us great responsibilities. By independence, we have lost the excuse of blaming the British for anything going wrong. If hereafter things go wrong, we will have nobody to blame except ourselves. There is great danger of things going wrong. Times are fast changing. People including our own are being moved by new ideologies. They are getting tired of government by the people. They are prepared to have Government for the people and are indifferent whether it is Government of the people and by the people. If we wish to preserve the Constitution in which we have sought to enshrine the principle of Government of the people, for the people and by the people, let us resolve not to be tardy in the recognition of the evils that lies across our path and which induce people to prefer Government for the people to Government by the people, nor to be weak in our initiative to remove them. That is the only way to serve the country. I know of no better.
